- 1 **CLIENT: [REDACTED] Corporation**
- 2 **CONTRACTOR: [Your Crew]**
- 3 **VESSEL: "Twilight" — Inner Rim Sector**
- 4 **TYPE: Personnel Evacuation — Priority Delta**

5 One week ago, Dr. Sofia Reiner — head of the R&D lab aboard the Twilight — was
6 caught attempting to transfer classified information to the Syndicate. Dr. Reiner was escorted
7 to HQ along with two top-clearance staff members. The remaining personnel were ordered
8 to freeze operations and await further instructions.

10 **The Corporation has now authorized your squad to complete the evacuation.**

12 **TASK 01 — Evacuate the employees (6 people) and the corporate prisoners (5**
13 **people). A crew manifest has been transmitted to each contractor.**

14 **TASK 02 — Activate the ship's autonomous mode via the internal control panel.**

15 *The Corporation reminds you of your signed NDAs. Exercise extreme caution when transporting prisoners to the*
16 *corporate vessel's cryopods.*

17 **PAYMENT CONDITIONS**

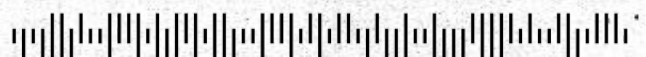
18 Contractor payment is released after the Twilight is secured, evacuees are
19 transferred, and corporate property is returned in acceptable condition. The Corporation
20 reserves the right to adjust final compensation after incident review.

Subject: Dr. Howard Meyer

Original Role: Senior Researcher, Twilight Laboratory

Experiment Code: CROWN GLASS / HM-02

Lead: Dr. Sofia Reiner

Status: Restricted

Subject HM-02 was selected following medical disqualification from further biological service. Subject was not informed of full experiment parameters.

Procedure began at 04:20 ship time.

At 04:37, subject received controlled lethal injection under the pretext of deep-transfer anesthesia.

Biological termination confirmed at 04:41.

Neural extraction and transfer sequence initiated at 04:44.

Synthetic body activation achieved at 05:19.

Initial cognitive continuity appeared successful. Subject recognized personnel, responded to name, retained professional memory, and requested return to work.

Subject was informed that complications during anesthesia required emergency medical intervention. Subject accepted explanation.

Post-transfer anomalies:

Delayed pain response

Mild tremor in both hands

Repeated questioning about procedure duration

Night terrors beginning after 72 hours
